

Initially a hobby, the site quickly picked up a following and by 2010 had gained over 24 million hits in the space of a month. The site became the 2nd most popular My Chemical Romance website just below the band official site. The popularity of Drinking Souls lead to a live mention by Zane Lowe on Radio 1 and a continuing stream of liaison with the bands record label Warner Brothers, as well as contact from MTV and notable publications such as Kerrang magazine, Rock Sound, Metal Hammer and Big Cheese. As the site expanded, social media grew and web trends developed, it was optimised for multiple platforms. Unfortunately, My Chemical Romance disbanded in early 2013. The site remains online as an accolade to the band and their fans. It is currently developed on WordPress and is one of the only surviving My Chemical Romance fansites.


